# THE WORD WAS WILL CHANGE A PRESENT TENSE VERBINTO A PAST TENSE SENTENCEV

## I WAS RUNNING (AWAY FROM YEAR 6). LUCY WAS DANCING. JOSEPH WAS PLAYING FOOTBALL.



If 'have' or 'had' is used the verbs are perfect

Present perfect I have played (simple) I have been playing (continuous) Past perfect I had played (simple) I had been playing (continuous)



#### Future

Further time can be expressed in a number of ways using *will* or present tenses

John <u>will arrive</u> tomorrow. John <u>will be arriving</u> tomorrow. John <u>is going to arrive</u> tomorrow. John <u>is arriving</u> tomorrow. John <u>arrives</u> tomorrow.

### The Past

This is when an event has already happened.



- I <u>walked</u> across to buy some sweets from the shop.
- I <u>shouted</u> to my brother in the playground.
  - ran down the lane with the dog.

### The Present

This is when an event is actually happening.



I <u>am walking</u> across to buy some sweets from the shop.

I <u>am shouting</u> to my brother in the playground.

I am running down the lane with the dog.

### The Future

This is when an event has not taken place yet.

I <u>will walk</u> across to buy some sweets from the shop.

I <u>will shout</u> to my brother in the playground.

I <u>will run</u> down the lane with the dog.



- I will like going to Manchester with my Mum. FUTURE

I will laugh at the clown in the circus.

- I am laughing at the clown in the circus.PRESENTI laughed at the clown in the circus.PASTI will laugh at the clown in the circus.FUTURE
- I swam in the pool on Wednesday.
- I am swimming in the pool on Wednesday. PRESENT I swam in the pool on Wednesday. PAST
