Maths

This week we will be learning how to draw patterns using Islamic geometry. This is for the first 3 lessons of the week. We have split it up into 3 different power points, but it can also be followed on the website as a PDF. Please don't print it out, it is much too big.

English

This week we will begin some work on Macbeth.

The end point in this unit will be a re-writing of a scene as a narrative from a chosen character's point of view.

PSHE:

This week in PSHE, we would like you to continue with your wellbeing chart that we had provided last week to you.

Oceans day:

On Monday 8th June it is Oceans day. For this afternoon, I have set up a reading comprehension which is differentiated. Also, in the afternoon, I have attached a PowerPoint about the use of plastic. Your child can create a poster or write a persuasive later about plastic in the ocean.

ICT:

LO: to find out what a text adventure is. To plan a story adventure.

Remind children that a text adventure is a computer game that uses text instead of graphics.

Talk to your children about any computer games that follow a story. Many adventure games are based on films or books.

Select a theme of their choice.

Before making a story adventure you will need to plan it. You can use a tool called 2connect.

Show the red riding hood examples - children can explore that.

Now open a blank 2connect file - You can click and type anywhere in the document. If you click on the page and a node appears that you don't want, it will disappear if you don't write in it. The boxes of writing are called nodes.

Now you can have a go at planning your story.

Genius project:

For this part of the summer term, the children will be taking part in a genius project. It is a project that is of their own choice. It gives them a chance to do a piece of writing, poster or a presentation on something that they are passionate on. It will be running for a number of weeks - in the past we have had things such as cheerleading, football skills, make up etc. For this week, your child will need to think about - topic, how they are going to present it and how they are going to research the information.

Example: Art - research the artist, collated the information, presented it and then did a painting link to that artist for a display.

Free time:
