## Present Perfect Continuous

Examples of present perfect continuous:

- I have been living here for five years.
- It has been raining since this morning.

We use the present perfect continuous to say how long things have been happening for up until now.

- John started learning Chinese in February. Now it is July. John has been learning Chinese for five months.
- It started raining on Sunday. It's still raining.
  It's been raining <u>since</u> Sunday.
