

# Blooming Beans - Year 1 Topic Work

Science:

Plants:

- **Name some garden plants.** Focus on plants found in Britain and look at plants and flowers
- **Tell the different between deciduous and evergreens trees.** Can you find any deciduous and evergreen trees? Can you explain the difference?
- **Name parts of a plant** (stem, leaf, flower, roots)
- **What does a plant need to grow?**
- Can you grow a plant at home? (if you can)

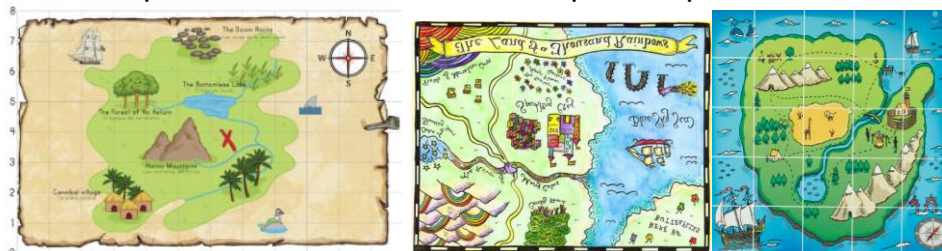

Geography:

- **Can you draw a map?** Draw a map of a real place - classroom/bedroom/living room. Think about the size of the objects you draw and where those objects are in the room.
- **Can you label a map?** This could be a treasure map or a map you have made up yourself. Can you include trees, mountains, rivers, cave, bridge etc? Can you label all the features on your map?



- **Give directions** (position and direction) - left/right up/down (Computing link - coding, see below)

Art:



**Giuseppe Arcimboldo** - observational drawing

- Using fruit and vegetables can you recreate a face just like Giuseppe Arcimboldo?



- Can you then draw what you see? This is called an **observational drawing**, take extra care to make sure you are controlling the pencil using the correct grip. You could copy a picture or draw your own fruit face.
- Can you **comment on the art work of Giuseppe Arcimboldo**? What do you like about his art work? What don't you like about it?

Design and Technology:

Make a puppet (taken from Terrific Toys unit)

- **Explore** puppets and their uses. Where might you find puppets? Do you have any puppets?
- Can you **design a hand puppet**? You might want to create a new monster or animal, you may even want to do character puppets for a story!
- What **materials** could you use to make a puppets? How might you **join** it together?
- Can you **make a puppet**? Use any materials you can find and be as creative as possible.
