Castles Topic Work

Science: (more science coming later this term!)

Materials

- What were castles made from?
- How many different types of castles were made? When were they made? (Motte and Bailey, Stone Keep, Concentric)
- Which was the strongest type? Which would last the longest in a battle?
- What did they used to make their weapons out of?

History:

DT:

Location of castles


- -Where would be a good place to build a castle?
