3. Why do you think the Romans were so successful?

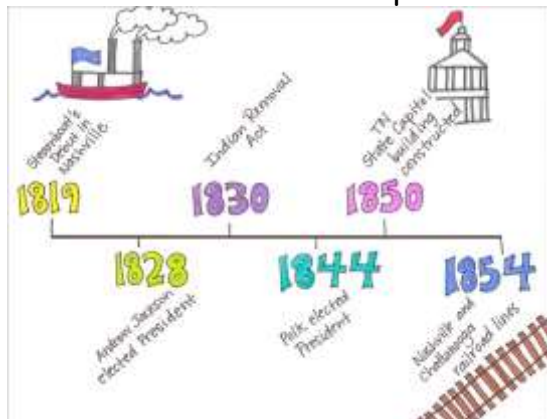
### Task 2

Remember how we ordered events on a timeline when we were learning about Ancient Egypt! We always place events in chronological order (the order in which they happened). \*Always remember to start with BC events before moving to events that happened in AD.\*
