Strategies to learn your spellings: Rainbow writing: Write over the word repeatedly in the colours of the rainbow so the children learn the pattern (ensure there is a space where the apostrophe is). Look at the spelling pattern: What sound do they all make? Is it the same sound for each word? Can you think of any more words that are homophones? Writing: Write a sentence for each of the spelling words. Dictionary work: Can you find other examples in the dictionary?
