

Improve your sentences

Start with a simple sentence:
'The dog barked.'



Throw the dice and up level your sentence.



1) Add an adverb or even better an adverbial phrase.



2) Add a powerful opener.



3) Add a connective and extend your sentence.



4) Add some adjectives.



5) Add a relative clause.



6) Add some interesting punctuation. You may need to slightly change your sentence.

'The dog barked.'



Examples:



1) The dog barked **ferociously/ at me ferociously.**



2) **Although I tiptoed past,** the dog barked.
Like a monster, the dog barked.



3) The dog barked, **whilst the postman hurried away.**



4) The **colossal, beast of a dog,** barked.



5) The dog, **who belonged to by friend,** barked.



6) The dog barked, **meanwhile his owner yelled, "Stop all the fuss."**
