Grammar	<p>LO: to use our grammar skills effectively and accurately</p> <p>Top tips:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Adjectives, verbs and nouns• Punctuation• Prefix - a letter or group of letters added to the beginning of a word to make a new word e.g. happy becomes unhappy• Inverted commas “ ”• Adverbs - a word or phrase that modifies an adjective or verb e.g. he walked slowly. The adverb 'slowly', provides us with more information about how the man walked.• 'a' or 'an' - remember, when a word begins with a vowel (A, E, I, O, U) the word before must be 'an' not 'a' for example, an egg.• Fronted adverbial - a word or phrase which modifies a verb or clause. <p>Use the questions on the sheet to revise what we have learnt so far in year 4.</p>
